

## Tim Beyer, CFA

### *Private Investor*

Tim Beyer, CFA, is a private investor after a 32-year career in investment management. Most recently, he was a managing director and senior portfolio manager at Sterling Capital Management, managing the firm's midcap value strategy for 17 years. Under his management, the midcap value strategy's assets under management grew from \$100 million to \$3.1 billion and finished in the top quartile of his peer group. Before that, Beyer managed the AIM Midcap Basic Value Mutual Fund for AIM (now part of Invesco) and the USAA Value Fund for USAA. He began his investment career at Bank of America, where he spent 12 years as both a fixed-income and equity analyst, and later as co-manager of a large-cap value fund and serving as director of asset allocation. Beyer is a CFA® charterholder and has served on the CFA Institute's Council of Examiners, writing the equity portion of the CFA exam for a full four-year term; he also served as a CFA exam grader for seven years.
